### **Energy & Water**

- \*1. Are the HVAC controls set to follow the Temperature Guidelines? (Individuals request an exemption from ECU Standard Temperature Practice if needed.)
- 2. Do you "Slay Vampire Energy" by using smart power strips OR unplugging electronic appliances when not in use?
- 3. Do you utilize localized light sources (ex: small lamps) instead of overhead lighting when possible?

#### **Food & Events**

- \*1. When providing food and/or beverages to guests at meetings or events, does the office order China service from ECU Catering Services or provide their own reusable service ware?
- \*2. Have you planned an event using the Green Event Guidelines, or are you planning a "green event" using these guidelines in the future?
- 3. Do you garden or raise your own food? It could be as simple as growing herbs on your windowsill.

# Health & Well-Being

- \*1. Has your office made an effort to use products that do not contain high levels of harmful chemicals, such as PFAS?
  - 2. Are you vegan or strictly plant-based?
- 3. Do you take personal days to rejuvenate on a regular basis?

## **Purchasing & Materials Management**

- \*1. Does your workplace purchase organic fabrics or recycled content fabrics when ordering shirts or uniforms?
- \*2. Does your workplace source giveaway items and "swag" from environmentally preferred or socially responsible businesses?
- \*3. Has the office established a "No Bottled Water Policy" and, if necessary, purchased a filtered pitcher or a filter attachment for the kitchen sink?

- 4. When placing orders for printing services and purchasing supplies for the office, do you make sure that paper products with 100% Recycled Content are specified?
- 5. Do you request that suppliers use the minimum amount of packaging necessary, or ensure that everything possible is recycled?
- 6. Do you purchase eco-friendly and compostable office products? (e.g. ink pens from recycled plastic, using paper or cardboard for single-use items, recycled printer paper, etc.)

#### Participation, Service, & Community Engagement

- \*1. Has your office participated in any type of natural area cleanup events? (This includes but is not limited to streams, rivers, parks, or roadways)
- \*2. Does your workplace typically try to collaborate with students, faculty, staff, researchers, or other campus and community partners to achieve departmental or sustainability goals?
- 3. Have you attended one of the films from the Sustainability Film & Discussion Series?
- 4. Have you attended at least one other Campus Sustainability Event or service opportunity?
- 5. Have you recruited another employee to start the Green Office Certification Program?
- 6. Are you a faculty member?
  - a. Do you use electronic textbooks instead of physical textbooks?
  - b. Have you participated in the Faculty Workshop on integrating sustainability into the curriculum?
  - c. Have you applied for a Sustainability Course Designation?

# <u>Transportation</u>

- \*1. Do you have a shared bicycle or other transportation system (e-bike, e-scooter, etc.) that can be used by any office employees?
- 2. Do you bike or walk to work on a regular basis? (E.g. once a week, when weather allows, etc.)

# Recycling & Zero Waste

\*1. Does the office keep a compost bin in a central location and empty it behind the closest dining hall or other compost collection site weekly?

- \*2. Is a collection bin setup to recycle miscellaneous materials that are frequently discarded in the office? (e.g. batteries, ink cartridges, etc.)
- 3. Have you removed your desk side trash can and now utilize a centrally located waste collection bin for non-recyclable materials?
